SERVICE LEARNING IN GUATEMALA (20 days / 19 nights) Antiqua - Vuelta Grande - Lake Atitlán - Chichicastenango





This program is developed for students interested to make a positive impact through service learning projects, deepen their understanding of other cultures and integrate in meaningful community service activities.

During the service learning experience in Vuelta Grande students will teach English lessons to the local students from age 3-13 at FUNCOLI'S Learning Center, which has been established in 2014 to give local children the opportunity to attend daily classes, receive a nourishing meal, and participate in art workshops. Additionally, students will help with the construction of dry latrines or ecological stoves. Dry latrines greatly reduce the contamination of ground water, while ecological stoves help to reduce respiratory ailments and deforestation.





Fundación Corazones Libres (FUNCOLI) is a Guatemala based non-profit organization. Its goal is to improve the education, health, infrastructure, living conditions and community development in the indigenous Maya communities of Vuelta Grande, Agua Colorada and La Cumbre which are all part of the municipality of Antigua Guatemala.

The Foundation has been active since 2013. From the beginning, CEPA Foundation has worked in close partnership with FUNCOLI to provide funding and to build a learning center that focuses on pre-and elementary school education, alphabetization and adult learning initiatives.

Besides the educational programs FUNCOLI secures basic healthcare for the local Maya population.

- Visit to the traditional open-air market, considered to be the largest in Central America
- Group dinner at a local restaurant

Chichicastenango - Tecpan - Antigua

Stay 2 nights at a 3-star hotel in Antigua

- Transportation by private bus
- Visit to the Iximche Mayan Ruins

Day 19 >> Sat.: Antigua

- Free day in Antigua for a final reflection
- Farewell dinner at a local restaurant

Antigua - Guatemala City

- Transportation by private bus to Guatemala City Airport
- Return flight (not included in the package price)
